Phone call scams



Numerous phone call scams are circulating. Scammers use these calls to steal your money and other information from you.

Prevent yourself becoming a victim by...



Don't answer or return any phone calls you are unsure of.



Block the number if possible / ask your landline provider if they can install a scam call blocking service.



If you're still unsure if the phone call is genuine, call whoever it may be (e.g. the bank) from a trusted source such as the official website.

Stop: Taking a moment to stop and think before parting with your money or information could keep you safe.

Challenge: Could it be fake? It's ok to reject, refuse, or ignore any requests. Only criminals will try to rush or panic you.
